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BRIEF ABOUT AIREXSA

AIREXSA was formed in the year 2017 and is registered under the Trade Union Act and Societies Registration Act, 1860. The Association is constituted by ex-servicemen who are re-employed in Central Government Departments, Central Statutory/Autonomous Bodies, PSUs, etc., and has members from more than 32 departments under its fold. AIREXSA is the only ex-servicemen association which has been acknowledged by DESW and DGR under the Ministry of Defence, DoPT and DOE, Ministry of Finance in all negotiations concerning re-fixation of initial pay on re-employment. It is a major stakeholder in all matters concerning service conditions and welfare of ex-servicemen. The Association is working to get recognised by the Ministry of Defence, and once this happens, it will take part in important negotiations with the MoD over service conditions and the welfare of ex-servicemen. The aim of the meeting is to enrol more number of re-employed ex-servicemen and strengthen the Association. Stronger the Association, better is the collective bargaining, greater is the benefit to the ex-servicemen fraternity.

OBJECTIVES OF AIREXSA

- Primary and most important objective is to seek pay re-fixation in the re-employed post.
- Ensuring cent-percent filling up of vacancies under ex-servicemen quota.
- Providing benefit of leave encashment of 300 days in the re-employed post.
- Beneficial transfer policy to re-employed ex-servicemen.
- Abolition of NPS i.e. re-employed ex-servicemen and restoration of Old Pension Scheme.
- Abolition of probation period for ex-servicemen in the re-employed post.
- Weightage to re-employed ex-servicemen in promotions and departmental examinations.
